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Report from 4th Meeting

Prague, Czech Republic 4th to 6th of Feb. 2014

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The 4th meeting in Prague, held from 4th to 6th was for us absolutely successful .

We were there from 1st to 6th of February, we established new contacts with several schools in order to set placements for new programme Erasmus plus Key Action 1.

We teach in different school systems, in schools with different programmes but we are all focused on our students. We are teacher and we are always talking about improvements on theoretical level.

Sometimes we are trying to compare our systems or part of school systems knowing how different they are and we are comparing different customs in our countries. We think that we are learning from each other how to prepare our students before going to the placements and this is something going on not only in the meetings but during the meals or sightseeing.

We visited some schools in Prague - with electrical and IT departments in our own organisation and in organisation of NUV and we are going to work on those contacts further on.

Our partners in this Leonardo partnership had actually the same aim - to talk about brochure which should help the teachers who are going to organize on the job training for their students as a little practical guide and to set agreement about new placements for our students.

Brochure will be our main product and the structure of the brochure is little confusing. We objected to it at the other partners and coordinator will make some improvements but we don't know when.

We agreed that the all brochures will be with the same lay out. NUV will provide each partner with 20 of them in English. We are going to print some brochures in Croatian (the number of exemplars depends on costs for preparation, so we can't tell how many brochures will be printed out in Croatian) and we will put our brochure on the Tesla's web site. We think that this version will be much better (much more teacher can learn from the brochure if in Internet!) because our colleagues will be invited to put any question to the topic - even if not described in the brochure.

We have another coordinator (4th!) and another person in charge and we hope to realize all the goals from this partnership on partnership level.

On our school level we understand this partnership as successful learning about another countries, educational systems and different customs
